- dogs who are part of our Dog Care Support for Seniors Program.

ElderDog's mission is to foster and support the relationship between ageing dogs and ageing people. Where possible we endeavour to rehome older dogs with older people.

Thank you for your interest in adopting an "Elder Dog." Because our dogs may have special age-related needs or have experienced recent disruption or stress, we take extra care to find homes that best suit the needs and abilities of both dog and human. Our application process helps us place our dogs in homes that will enable the human-animal relationship to flourish.

- **3.** The next step is to arrange a meeting with one of our volunteers in your home and, finally, a get-acquainted meeting with a dog.



Because we typically are entrusted with the care and placement of senior dogs whose companions have no choice but to rehome their beloved dog, we make a commitment to do whatever we can to place elder dogs in a kind and loving environment where they can be comfortable for the rest of their lives. In our Credo, we identify qualities such as dignity, respect, and comfort as underlying all that we do. We take care to ensure that all of our decisions regarding placement of dogs aligns with these values.

Please note : We, at ElderDog Canada, commit to dogs entrusted to our care for the rest of their lives. Once your application is approved and a suitable dog placed in your care, there is a minimum two-week trial period before an adoption is finalized. During this period we will follow up regularly with you. Once it is determined that the placement is the most suitable doghuman-environment match, the adoption will be finalized with a commitment letter.
If, at any time for ANY reason, you can no longer care for or keep the Elder Dog you have adopted, it is necessary to contact ElderDog Canada to arrange for the dog's immediate return to our organization. Under NO circumstances should an Elder Dog be rehomed without ElderDog's involvement. Please initial to indicate your understanding of your commitment to ElderDog
