- work closely with Education and Outreach Coordinator and Pawd Leader to ensure Pawd activities and events are promoted within and outside the Pawd
- liaise with National Communications and Social Media Coordinators
- participate in Pawd executive meetings
- participate in meetings with Communications Coordinators from other Pawds

Requirements:

- facility with social media platforms Facebook and Instagram
- knowledge of or willingness to learn basic graphic design skills (in Canva)
- experience building relationships with community partners
- strong interpersonal and written communications skills
